The Inuit-specific front-line programs and services are delivered by a staff of more than 100 and range from food security, housing and homelessness, culture, education, employment services, to residential substance-use treatment, youth programming, childcare services, Elders programming and more.

Executive Director, Amanda Kilabuk proudly added, "As more Inuit continue to move south, it is important that organizations, like TI, provide Inuit-specific programs and services that support urban Inuit. We are extremely proud of where we are today, designing and delivering programming but also advocating at local, provincial, and national tables. We encourage and support the development of urban Inuit initiatives across Canada."

To honour the occasion, during the week of March 14th to 18th, TI will host games and contests on our [social media](#) pages open to urban Inuit and award 35 prizes throughout the week. Later this year, celebrations are planned that will include community celebrations and a large community BBQ.

Today, TI is considered a home away from home for urban Inuit. TI operates four unique building locations in Ottawa with the head office at 1071 Richmond Road and additional satellite operations around the GTA. TI is a registered non-profit and offers tax deductible receipts for all donations.
